

**Huntsdale Town Council Meeting
October 17, 2006 6:30 P.M.
Katy's Little Lodge B&B
Minutes**

Present: Debby Lancaster, Dallas Lancaster, Ed McGee, Dorothy Eberhart, Kathy McGee

Meeting called to order by Mayor Debby Lancaster at 6:33 p.m.

Minutes from the September meeting were approved pending the following amendments:

1. Fix page numbering
2. Change spelling of mayors name on 1st page
3. Change name of business Ed McGee works for to HomKor of Missouri
Dorothy motioned Ed seconded

Treasurers Report: Noted that price of electric bill paid on October 10, 2006 included the final billing for the 3 town meters that were shut off.

Dorothy Eberhart announced that Patty Orscheln donated one thousand dollars to the Town of Huntsdale and five hundred dollars to the Huntsdale Festival account. Town council members thanked Patty for her generosity.

Old Business

Road Paint

Ed McGee stated that he had 4 buckets of white road paint that should cover the 1056' of road that needs to be marked. The line needs to be 4" wide and applied with a ¾" nap roller. HomKor of Missouri donated the paint to the town.

Ana Lopez with talk with Mid City Lumbar to see if their donation to the town could be used for paint rollers, extension handles, etc.

Update on Homeland Security Committee

Debby Lancaster, a member of the Homeland Security Committee, stated that the two men from Washington D.C. came to Boone County. They were interested in the Boone County Security infrastructure and local concerns. They also asked what the barges could haul on the river.

They took the information back to FEMA and bypassed Jefferson City.

Missouri Municipal League

Debby Lancaster stated that we did not receive the Missouri Municipal League (MML) Conference *Scholarships*.

New Business

Building permit – Katfish Katy’s shower house

The building permit application was submitted to Kurt Shryack, the town Building Code Mission, for preliminary approval and placing before the Town Council for vote.

Kurt Shryack stated that everything appeared to be in order for flood plain design and septic system. He recommended to the Brown’s that they have the Health Department inspect and certify the septic system prior to covering it with dirt.

He also stated that the design was environmentally friendly with plans for solar powered water heaters, etc.

Ed McGee discussed the merits of solar water heaters.

Ana Lopez is investigating getting 1 gpm jetted showerheads instead of the standard 1.5 gpm as a way to reduce water usage without adversely affecting the water pressure.

A check for twenty-five dollars was presented with the application and plans.

Ed McGee suggested we advertise statewide. Ana and several other town members told him that we are already doing that.

Mention was made of the Daniel Boone Heritage Festival and reassurances were made that the Heritage Festival is prior to the Huntsdale Festival and will not detract.

Linda Brown told those present that the lady who was going to do the puppet show, wanted to be in period. She is working on a grant to help pay for more authentic puppets and material. She wants to be ready to perform in 2007.

Linda is going to devote her entire displaced case to Native American and Rendezvous era merchandise. She is going to visit more activities and encourage people to visit the campground and commit to the rendezvous.

The next official Huntsdale Festival Committee will meet November 8, 2006 at 6:30 p.m. at Katy's Little Lodge.
