

**Huntsdale Town Council Meeting
December 19, 2006 - 6:30 P.M.
Katy's Little Lodge B&B
Minutes**

Present: Debby Lancaster, Dallas Lancaster, Ed McGee, Dorthy Eberhart, Kathy McGee

Meeting called to order by Mayor Debby Lancaster at 6:31 p.m.

Minutes from the November: Kathy McGee motioned minutes be approved.
Dallas Lancaster 2nd the motion.

Treasurers Report: December 2006 Income Statement reviewed and approved.

Old Business

Road Signs

Dallas gave a verbal review of the costs for signs, pole, and hardware to set up the road signs at the corner of Hunt and Railroad.

- 2 road signs at \$22.50 for total of \$45. (Additional cost of adding St. in small letter acknowledged and approved.)
- 1 galvanized pole at \$30 (Ed McGee stated he has a galvanized pole he will donate)
- Miscellaneous hardware
- Labor to put up the signs

Total estimated cost of \$100 (minus cost of pole).

Vote was taken and unanimous approval given for payment of said expenses.

Road Paint

Ed McGee stated that he has the paint for the project.

Ana Lopez will get the supplies needed prior to the next break in the weather, so that the roads can be painted as soon as there is sufficient time with temperatures high enough for the paint to set properly.

New Business

Election Filing

Debby Lancaster handed out and “Village of Huntsdale Notice of Filing for General Election” documents and placed a stack of “Declaration of Candidacy” on a table for any interested town members to fill out and turn in if interested in running for an office.

Seats open for candidates are for 2 seats on the Board of Trustees. Said seats are currently occupied by Kathy McGee and Debby Lancaster.

Many town members encouraged the Mayor Debby Lancaster to run for re-election. She stated that she was considering the matter.

Dorthy Eberhart applies for Electric Permit

Dorthy Eberhart stated that changes in their building plans require Boone Electric Co-Op to move lines. Boone Electric Co-op will not send an engineer to look over the options available until a current Huntsdale Building Permit is issued. Therefore, she is applying for an electric building permit.

Mayor Debby Lancaster said that since the building was grand fathered in that the town should just sign the permit as a technicality. All other town council members agreed and the permit was signed.

Debby requested that she be notified if there were any other issues with Boone County Electric as the approved building codes had not been in effect very long. She wanted to make sure the codes are honored properly.

Festival Update

Ana Lopez gave an brief update of the ongoing preparation for the Huntsdale Festival. The Festival web page has been updates with better pictures as per the request of traders contacted during the last year.

Ana stated that Gail Daly sent her a 2 page history of the town of Huntsdale, that contained things she hadn't known. She promised to send the pictures, history, and the test portion of the Katfish Katy web page to Debby Lancaster via email.
